



January Blooms at the Crosby Arboretum!

Common name	Species	Structure of Interest
Little Blue Stem	<i>Andropogon</i> spp.	Tan, leafy stems bearing white, fluffy seeds.
Plume Grass	<i>Erianthus giganteus</i>	Tall grass with feathery seeds arising from the top.
American Beech	<i>Fagus grandifolia</i>	Tan, drooping leaves clinging to dormant stems.
Deciduous Holly	<i>Ilex decidua</i>	Bright red fruit clinging to dormant stems.
Gallberry	<i>Ilex glabra</i>	Black fruit borne on small, leafy stems.
American Holly	<i>Ilex opaca</i>	Bright red fruit born on small stems. Leaves with sharp prickles.
Yaupon Holly	<i>Ilex vomitoria</i>	Bright red fruit clustered on short stems below small, dark green leaves.
Pond Cypress	<i>Taxodium ascendens</i>	Striking trees with tan, shredding bark, cylindrical crowns.
Bald Cypress	<i>Taxodium distichum</i>	Striking trees with grayish, furrowed bark.
