Common Name Species Structure of Interest

Parrot Pitcher Plant Solitary, red, nodding flowers. Sarracenia psittacina

Leaves laying along the surface of the ground, green with red veins. Small plant with flower clusters

consisting of small orange flowers. Short Milkwort Polygala ramosa

Small, yellow flowers in a flat-

topped cluster.

Polygala lutea

Aletris lutea

Sundew Small, red-leaf plants with glandular Drosera brevifolia

hairs. Flowers solitary and pinkish

white.

Meadow Beauty Rhexia mariana Upright plants with light pink

flowers and long, bent stamens

(yellow) in the center.

Yellow Rhexia Rhexia lutea Upright plants with yellow flowers

and long stamens that point upwards. Yellow, bell-shaped flowers in tall

clusters.

Gold-Crest Lophiola americana Whitish plants with small yellow

'hairy' flowers.

Milkweed Asclepias lanceolata Small orange to reddish orange

> flowers in flat-topped clusters. White flowers with drooping

'petals'. Resembles a lily.

Dichromena colorata

Water Lily Nymphaea odorata Aquatic plant with white many-

> petaled flowers. Numerous yellow stamens are found in the centers.

Cow Lily Nuphar luteum Aquatic plant with yellow, globular

flowers.

Shrub to small tree. Drooping flower Cyrilla racemiflora

clusters with small, white flowers.

Pickerelweed

Pontederia cordata

Aquatic plant with solitary flower clusters with small blue flowers

marked with yellow.

Lizard's Tail

Saururus cernuus

Aquatic plant; upright with a long,

drooping cluster of white flowers; sepals and petals absent; long, white

stamens.

Southern Magnolia

Sweetbay Magnolia

Magnolia grandiflora

Magnolia virginiana

Large dark, green leaves with reddish

hairs on the undersides. Flowers

white, showy and very fragrant.

Pale green leaves with white to silvery hairs on the undersides. Bark

light gray to whitish. Flowers

similar to M. grandiflora but smaller. Small tree with often mis-shapen

leaves due to galls. Leaves aromatic.

Small, yellow flowers in axillary

clusters.
