## Structure of Interest

Several species in flower this month. Composite flowers with yellow ray flowers and yellow to brown disc flowers. Resembles a sunflower. Terminal, solitary head per stem; ray

Terminal, solitary head per stem; ray flowers yellow disc flowers reddish

to purple.

Flowers in terminal clusters; disc flowers yellow, ray flowers absent. Several species in flower this month. Tall plant with branched flower

clusters that are highly branched. Tiny disc and ray flowers.

Short plant with small lance-shaped leaves. Flowers with blue, white, or rose ray flowers, disc flowers yellow. Flat-topped to rounded flower cluster

consisting of numerous purple disc

flowers, ray flowers absent.

Tall plant with terminal, flat-topped flower clusters; disc flowers purple,

ray flowers absent.

Upright plant with lance shaped to elliptic leaves; flowers in terminal clusters, setting seed this month.

Look for puffy, gray parachute-like structure bearing small, black seeds.

Boneset/Roundleaf Eupatorium rotundifolium Tall, herbaceous plants with sessile, Eupatorium rounded leaves that occur opposite along the stem. Look for puffy, gray parachute-like structure bearing small, black seeds. Common Boneset Plant similar to E. rotundifolium Eupatorium serotinum except leave are lance-shaped to oval. Ladies' Hatpins/ Eriocaulon decangulare Terminal solitary heads on long stems; heads white and leaves a Pipewort 'powdery' residue when touched. Gerardia Agalinis tenuifolia Upright, highly branched annual with filiform leaves. Flowers tubular, purple with a twp lobed upper lip and three lobed lower lip lined with yellow. Spiked Lobelia Small plant with alternate, sessile Lobelia spicata leaves. Flowers lavender with a two lobed upper lip and three lobed lower lip. Inkberry Ilex glabra Shrub producing small black drupes. In and Around the Pond Common Name Species Structure of Interest Climbing Hempweed Mikania scandens Climbing vine with heart-shaped leaves; setting seeds this month. Look for puffy, gray parachute-like structure bearing small, black seeds. Upright aquatic plant with axillary Floating Primrose Willow Ludwigia peploides flowers, yellow, five-petaled. Cardinal Flower Lobelia cardinalis Plant on the Woodland Trial. Upright growing along the stream. Scarlet, three-lobed flowers. Shrub with pinnately compound Winged Sumac Rhus copallinum

leaves that are winged along the center portion. Producing red drupes
